ABOUT

Founded in 2000, The Woodlands Preparatory School is a nonsectarian college preparatory day school enrolling a total of 335 girls and boys in grades kindergarten through twelfth grade. The school sits in the heart of The Woodlands, Texas, which has become a very international community serving families of executives in companies related to the oil and gas industries. With this in mind, Woodlands Prep School places an emphasis on math and science, and after six graduating classes, we have noted the trend to be more than 50% of our graduates enter a technical field, such as engineering, in their first year of college.

LOCATION

The Windsor School is an independent, coeducational, middle and high school, located in the vibrant community of Flushing, New York. Queens is the easternmost and largest in area of the five boroughs of New York City, geographically adjacent to the borough of Brooklyn at the western end of Long Island.



CURRICULUM

The Woodland Preparatory School is organized into two divisions – Lower School and Upper School. The Upper School consists of grades seven through twelve. There are two divisions within the upper school.

Students in the Upper School undergo a rigorous college preparatory program. The woodlands preparatory school currently offers Advanced Placement courses approved by the College Board and pre-AP courses in all mathematics, science, and English courses as well as social studies, foreign languages, and art. Other courses include music, drama, technology, physical education and electives such as journalism and yearbook.
