# Welcome to Eastbourne

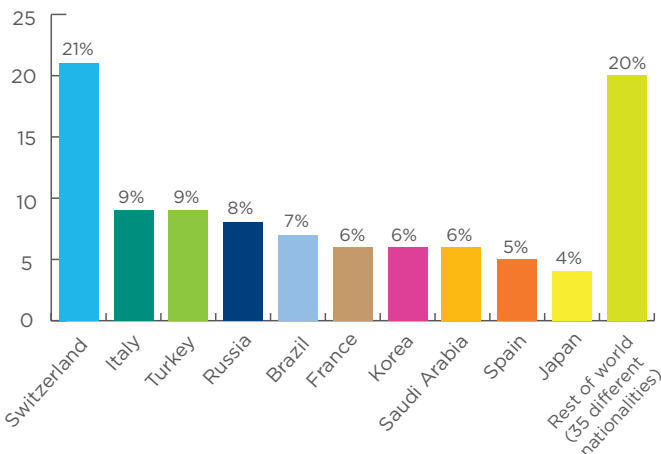
